
Occupations of 35–44 year-old people in Marrickville

Key features: The most characteristic occupation in Marrickville amongst people aged 35–44 was professionals – 32% of the people were in this group, the largest proportion. This was 4% greater than the proportion across all age groups in Marrickville and 10% higher than the proportion in the same age group across Sydney.





This bubble chart lets you see at a glance how the occupations of Marrickville's people aged 35–44 vary in size and differ from those of all people in Marrickville and from 35–44 year-old people in Sydney. Each bubble represents one of the occupations. Larger bubbles mean there were more people aged 35–44 with that occupation. Higher bubbles (eg the one for those who were professionals) show that the proportion of 35–44 year-old people with that occupation was larger than the proportion of all people in Marrickville. Bubbles further to the right indicate that occupation was more common in this age group locally than in Sydney (eg those who were professionals).

Occupations of 35–44 year-old people in Marrickville


Those who were professionals were the most common group amongst 35–44 year-old people in 2001, with 3,215 people, or 32% of the workers in this age group. As well, there were 1,278 people (13%) who were clerical/sales/service workers; 1,173 people (12%) who were technicians; 1,089 people (11%) who were managers; and 836 people who were tradespersons (8%).

The occupation which was noticeably more common amongst this age group than amongst all people in Marrickville was professionals, which had 4.4% more of the age group than of all workers – 32.4% to 28.0%. As well, the proportion who were managers was 3.0% larger. On the other hand, there were 3.2% fewer of this age-sex group who were clerical/sales/service workers, and 3% fewer who were clerical/sales assistants.

Compared with the same age-sex cohort in Sydney, the biggest difference was that locally there were 10% more who were professionals. There were 3% fewer who were clerical/sales/service workers and 2% fewer who were tradespersons.

The differences between the occupations of males and females is very noticeable, with the male:female ratio ranging from 6.3 males per female among those who were tradespersons to 0.31 (or 3.2 females per male) among those who were senior clerical/service workers.

Note that these percentages are of the total number of workers in the age group. The total does not include any with other responses, or with unclassified responses, or who did not answer the question, or overseas visitors.




Occupations of people in Marrickville, by age

The chart and table below illustrate how the occupations of people in Marrickville varied across age groups in 2001. Each band in the chart represents one occupation – the lowest band represents those who were managers; the next, those who were professionals; up to the top band, those who were labourers. The left end of each band represents the youngest age group and the right end represents the oldest age group. The 35–44 age group is boxed.

The width of each band at any point represents the proportion of that age group who were the occupation represented by the band. For the 35–44 people, the widest band represents their most common occupation, those who were professionals. This is the second bottom of the nine bands. The band comes from nil among those under 15; then widens from young adults to middle age, as the proportion who were professionals increased, before narrowing from middle to old age, as the proportion who were professionals fell. The band ends widening among those aged 75+.

Similarly, the second widest band (for 35–44 year-olds) represents those who were clerical/sales/service workers. This is the fourth top of the nine bands. The band starts with no width among those under 15; then narrows from young adults to middle age, as the proportion who were clerical/sales/service workers decreased with age, before staying even from middle to old age, as the proportion stayed relatively constant. The band narrows as it ends at those aged 75+.
