Managers and Administrators include Generalist and Specialist Managers and Farm Managers

Professionals include those in Science, Building and Engineering, Business and Information, Sales, Computing and Human Resource as well as Accountants, Librarians, Doctors, Nurse, Pharmacists, Health Professionals, Teachers, Social Workers, Economists, Photographers, Musicians and Actors

Associate Professionals include Technical Officers, Investment Advisers, Office Managers, Computing Technicians, Shop, Restaurant and Hotel Managers, Sport Managers, Enrolled Nurses, Police Officers, Senior Fire Fighters and Retail Buyers

Tradespersons include Machinists, Motor Mechanics, Electricians, Bricklayers, Signwriters, Cooks, Shearers, Gardeners, Screen Printers, Cabinetmakers, Hairdressers, Upholsterers, Florists, Fire Fighters and most Defence Force Members

Advanced Clerical and Service Workers include Secretaries, Bookkeepers, Insurance Agents, Travel Attendants

Intermediate Clerical, Sales and Service Workers include Clerks, Keyboard Operators, Receptionists, Bank Workers, Library Assistants, Sales Representatives, Checkout Supervisors, Child Care Workers, Waiters, Prison Officers, Travel Agents

Intermediate Production and Transport Workers include Forklift Drivers, Mill Operators, Sewing Machinists, Machine Operators, Road and Rail Transport Drivers, Miners, Storepersons

Elementary Clerical, Sales and Service Workers include Filing Clerks, Switchboard Operators, Messengers, Sales Assistants, Telemarketers, Guards, Housekeepers

Labourers include Cleaners, Process Workers, Packers, Labourers, Farm Hands, Kitchenhands, Garbage Collectors, Handypersons
